Be Prepared

- ⇒ Write out your personal testimony.
- ⇒ Try to edit it to 2-3 minutes.
- ⇒ Practice it with a friend or spouse.
- ⇒ Try to make it sound natural.
- ⇒ Above all, let it flow from your heart. Don't worry if it doesn't come out exactly as you practiced.

Witnessing Tips

- 1) Look for opportunities to share.
- 2) Share your testimony . . . share from your heart.
- 3) Trust God with the results.
*You are not responsible for the results.
- 4) There is no bad witnessing.
*If you share, you have already done more than if you said nothing.
- 5) You are a cog in the wheel.
*Concept of reaping and others sowing.
- 6) Ask them if you can pray for them.

Do you know how to lead someone to Christ?

It's really very simple. Paul said to a jailor "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved." (Acts 16:31) John 3:16 says, "believe in Jesus and you will not perish but have eternal life".

The Four Spiritual Laws really helps to simplify the basics and takes the fear out of witnessing. Here are the basics of the **4 Spiritual Laws**.

- 1) God loves you and offers a wonderful plan for your life. (John 3:16)
- 2) Man is sinful and separated from God. (Rom. 3:23; 6:23)
- 3) Jesus Christ is the only provision for man's sin. (John 14:6)
- 4) We must individually receive Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord; then we can know and experience God's love and plan for our lives. (John 1:12; Eph. 2:8-9)
